### **POLICE JURY ELECTION DISTRICTS**

***Section 6-18 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (POLICE JURY DISTRICTS ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015 by Ordinance No. 1015):***

- **District No. 1 is comprised of Precinct 1 and the East division of Precinct 4.**
- **District No. 2 is comprised of the West Division of Precinct 4.**
- **District No. 3 is comprised of Precinct 16B**
- **District No. 4 is comprised of Precincts 8, 9, and, 16C, the North division of Precinct 12, and the East division of Precinct 17.**
- **District No. 5 is comprised of Precincts 2, 13, and 15, the South division of Precinct 12, and the West division of Precinct 17.**
- **District No. 6 is comprised of Precinct 16A**
- **District No. 7 is comprised of Precinct 5S**
- **District No. 8 is comprised of Precinct 5N**

### **PRECINCT BOUNDARIES**

***Section 6-16 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (THOSE PRECINCTS CHANGED BY ORDINANCE ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015 ARE SO DESIGNATED by Ordinance No. 1015):***

- (a) *Precinct 1:* Beginning at the northwest corner of Cameron Parish, point being where the Sabine River and Cameron Parish meet; thence following the center of the Sabine River to a point where it enters Sabine Lake; thence following the east bank of Sabine Lake to the Gulf of Mexico. Point being the southwest corner of Cameron Parish; thence from said point easterly along the shore of the Gulf of Mexico to the west bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel; thence north following the west bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel until it meets the west bank of Calcasieu Lake near Long Point; thence in a southwesterly direction following the West Bank of Calcasieu Lake until it intersects with the Sabine Refuge Back Ridge Canal; thence following the Sabine Refuge Back Ridge Canal in a westerly direction until it intersects the Sabine Refuge Beach Canal; thence following the Sabine Refuge Beach Canal in a northerly direction until it intersects with the Sabine Refuge Starks North Canal; thence following the Sabine Refuge Starks North Canal in a westerly direction until it intersects with the right prong of Black Bayou; thence following the east bank in a northerly direction to the north boundary of Cameron Parish; thence in a westerly direction to the point of beginning.
- (b) *Precinct 2:* Beginning in the center of the Calcasieu Ship Channel and the shoreline of the Gulf of Mexico for a point of beginning; thence in a northerly direction following the east side of Jetties Road to the south side of Highway, 27-82; thence in an easterly direction until intersecting Dan Street;

thence in a northerly direction down the center of Dan Street until it reaches Asa Street; thence westerly to School Street; thence northerly to Franklin Street; thence westerly to Recreation Center Lane; thence in a southerly direction to the north side of Smith Circle; thence westerly to Back Ridge Road; thence northerly to Gravity Drainage No. 3 ditch; thence in a westerly direction following said ditch until intersecting the east side of Wakefield Road; thence in a northerly direction until intersecting East Fork Road; thence following the south side of East Fork Road in an easterly direction until intersecting with McDaniel Pipe Yard Lane; thence in a northerly direction following said lane to the east bank of East Fork Pass; thence in a northwesterly direction across East Fork Pass to the Southeast Bank of St. Johns Island; thence in a northerly direction following the southeast bank of St. Johns Island around until it intersects the west bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel; thence due south to a point of the East Bank of Calcasieu Ship Channel and the shoreline of the Gulf of Mexico and the point of beginning.

- (c) *Precinct 3*: Beginning at the intersection of the West bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel and Gulfway Drive, thence in a Westerly direction following Gulfway Drive to its intersection with Meyers Road, thence in a southerly direction following Meyers Road to its intersection with Lake Breeze Road, thence in a Westerly direction following Lake Breeze Road to its intersection with State Highway 27, thence in a southerly direction following State Highway 27 to its intersection with the Sabine Refuge Back Ridge Canal, thence in an easterly direction following the Sabine Refuge Back Ridge Canal to its intersection with the Northwest bank of West Cove, thence following the bank of West Cove in a northeasterly direction to its intersection with Calcasieu Lake, thence following the west bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel to the point of beginning.
- (d) *Precinct 4—East Division (Police Jury District No. 1)*: Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of State Highway 27 and the centerline of the Lake Breeze Road; thence east along the centerline of the Lake Breeze Road to its intersection with the centerline of Myers Road; thence north along the centerline of Myers Road to its intersection with the centerline of Gulfway Drive; thence east along the centerline of Gulfway Drive to its intersection with the centerline of the West bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel; thence north along the centerline of the West bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel to its intersection with the centerline of the Alphonse Lane Drainage Lateral; thence north along the centerline of Alphonse Lane Drainage Lateral to its intersection with the centerline of Alphonse Lane; thence west along the centerline of the Alphonse Lane to its conversion to the centerline of Pete Seay Circle; thence west along the centerline of Pete Seay Circle to its intersection with the centerline of Bourgport Road; thence west/southwest along the centerline of Bourgport Road to its intersection with the centerline of State Highway 27; thence south along the centerline of State Highway 27 to its intersection with the centerline of its southernmost intersection with Old Town Road; thence east along the centerline of Old Town Road to its intersection with the centerline of Magnolia Road; thence south along the centerline of Magnolia Road to its intersection with the centerline of Channelview Drive; thence west along the centerline of Channelview Drive to its intersection with the centerline of Jordan Lane; thence west/southwest along the centerline of Jordan Lane to its intersection with the centerline of Welch Drive; thence north along the centerline of Welch Drive to its intersection with the centerline of State Highway 27; thence west/south along the centerline of State Highway 27 to its intersection with centerline of the Lake Breeze Road, being the point of beginning.
- (e) *Precinct 4—West Division (Police Jury District No. 2)*: Beginning at a point where the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line meets Black Bayou; thence in a southerly direction following Black Bayou to its intersection with the Starks North Canal; thence in a easterly direction following the Starks North Canal to intersection with the Sabine Refuge Beach Canal; thence in a southerly direction following the Sabine Refuge Beach Canal to its intersection with the Sabine Refuge Back Ridge Canal; thence in an easterly direction following the Sabine Refuge Back Ridge Canal to its intersection with State Highway 27; thence in a northerly direction following State Highway 27 to its intersection with Welch Drive; thence in a southerly direction following Welch Drive to its intersection with Jordan Lane; thence in a north-easterly direction following Jordan Drive to its intersection with Channelview Drive; thence in an easterly direction to its intersection with Magnolia Road; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection with Old Town Road; thence in a westerly direction to its intersection with State Highway 27; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection with Burgport

Road; thence in an easterly direction to its intersection with Pete Seay Circle; thence in an easterly direction to its conversion to Alphonse Lane; thence in an easterly direction to its intersection with Alphonse Lane Drainage Lateral; thence in a southerly direction to its intersection with the West bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel; thence in a northerly direction following the West bank of the Calcasieu Ship Channel to its intersection with the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line; thence in a westerly direction to the point of beginning.

- (f) *Precinct 5N*: **BOUNDARIES CHANGED BY ORDINANCE ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015** Beginning at the intersection of State Highway 385 and State Highway 384, THENCE in a northerly direction following State Highway 385 to the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line, THENCE in a westerly direction along the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line to its intersection with the Intracoastal Canal, THENCE in a southerly direction following the Intracoastal Canal to its intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a easterly direction following State Highway 384 to its intersection with State Highway 385, this being the point of commencement.
- (f) *Precinct 5S*: **BOUNDARIES CHANGED BY ORDINANCE ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015** Beginning at the point where State Highway 384 intersects with the Big Lake Pontoon Bridge at the Intracoastal Waterway, THENCE following the east bank of the Intracoastal Waterway in a southerly direction to the point where the levee between the Intracoastal Waterway meets the southern boundary of Willow Lake (also being the boundary between current U.S. Census blocks 2151 and 2147), THENCE following the impoundment/bank of Willow Lake in an easterly direction, then in a northerly direction to its intersection with Lateral 15 of Gravity Drainage District No. 8, THENCE in a northerly direction following Lateral 15 of Gravity Drainage District No. 8 to its connection to the northwest point of the northern bank of the marsh impoundment (being the boundary between current U.S. Census blocks 2141 and 2142), THENCE in an easterly direction along the aforesaid marsh impoundment to its intersection with Tans Road (being the boundary between current U.S. Census blocks 2141 and 2142), THENCE in a northerly direction following Tans Road to its intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a easterly direction following State Highway 384 to its intersection with N Precht Road, THENCE in a southerly direction following N Precht Road to its intersection with W Precht Road, THENCE in an easterly direction following W Precht Road to its intersection with Sweet Lake Camp Road, THENCE in a southerly direction following Sweet Lake Camp Road to its intersection with the Unical Ditch canal at the Unical Timber bridge, THENCE in a southerly direction following along the Sweet Lake Camp drainage canal to its intersection with an impoundment along the eastern bank of Sweet Lake, THENCE in a southerly direction following along Sweet Lake Camp drainage canal until its intersection with an impoundment along the eastern bank of Sweet Lake, THENCE in a southerly direction along the impoundment along the eastern bank of Sweet Lake to its intersection with the north bank of the Intracoastal Waterway (at the eastern bank of the opening in the levee impoundment), THENCE in a westerly direction, then northerly, along the Intracoastal Waterway to its intersection with the Sweetlake canal, THENCE in a westerly direction following along the Sweetlake canal to the East bank of Calcasieu Lake, THENCE in a northerly direction following along the East bank of Calcasieu Lake to the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish line, THENCE in an easterly direction following along the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish line to the East Bank of the Intracoastal Canal, THENCE in a southeasterly direction following the Intracoastal Canal to the intersection of State Highway 384, the Big Lake Pontoon Bridge, and the Intracoastal Waterway, this being the point of commencement.
- (g) *Precinct 8*: Beginning at a point where the Intracoastal Canal meets the west bank of Grand Lake; thence northerly following said bank until meeting the Mermentau River; thence continuing in a northerly direction following the center flow channel of the Mermentau River until it intersects with the center of Lake Arthur and following said center of Lake Arthur north until intersecting the Jefferson Davis and Cameron Parish boundary line; thence in a westerly direction following said parish boundary line until intersecting the center flow channel of Lacassine Bayou; thence in a southerly direction to the Intracoastal Canal; thence in a easterly direction following the north bank until intersecting the west bank of Grand Lake and the point of beginning.
- (h) *Precinct 9*: Beginning at a point where the Intracoastal Canal meets the east bank of Grand Lake; thence northwesterly following said bank until meeting the Mermentau River; thence continuing in a

northerly direction following the center flow channel of the Mermentau River until reaching the center of Lake Arthur and following the center of said lake north until reaching Cameron and Jefferson Davis Parish boundary line; thence in an easterly direction until reaching the Cameron and Vermilion Parish boundary line, this point being the northeast corner of Cameron Parish; thence in a southerly direction following the Cameron and Vermilion Parish boundary line to the north bank of the Intracoastal Canal; thence following the Intracoastal Canal in a northwesterly direction until intersecting with the east shore line of Grand Lake and the point of beginning.

- (i) *Precinct 12—North Division (Police Jury District 4)*: Beginning at a point where the Intracoastal Canal intersects with the west bank of Grand Lake; thence in a southerly direction following the west bank of Grand Lake until it intersects with the Mermentau River; thence in a southerly direction following the south bank of the Mermentau River to a point where Mermentau River Road goes due north to Chenier Perdue Road; thence in a northerly direction following the east side of Mermentau River Road to a point where it intersects with Chenier Perdue Road; thence in a westerly direction on Chenier Perdue Road until it intersects with the Little Chenier Canal; thence continuing in a westerly direction following Highway 1143 until it intersects William Duhon Estate Road; thence in a northerly direction following said road to a point which intersects with a levee on the north property line; thence in a westerly direction following said levee until connecting School Section West Levee; thence northerly to School Section North Levee; thence westerly until it connects with High Island Ridge; thence continuing westerly until intersecting with the center line of Highway 27; thence turning in a northerly direction following the center of Highway 27 until intersecting the north bank of the Intracoastal Canal; thence in an easterly direction following the north bank of the Intracoastal Canal until it intersects with the west bank of Grand Lake and the point of beginning.
- (j) *Precinct 12—South Division (Police Jury District 5)*: Beginning at a point where Chenier Perdue Road intersects with the Little Chenier Canal; thence in a southerly direction following the Little Chenier Canal until it intersects the south side of Pumpkin Ridge; thence in westerly direction until intersecting F.O. Theriot Road; thence in a northerly direction to the south side of Highway 1143; thence in an easterly direction along Highway 1143 to the point of beginning.
- (k) *Precinct 13* Beginning at a point where the Gulf of Mexico meets the east bank of the Mermentau River Channel; thence following the east bank until intersecting with the south side of Highway 82; thence in a westerly direction following Highway 82 until it intersects the Shell Oil Company Kings Bayou Road, thence in a northerly direction following the east side of said road until it intersects the Mayo Boudreaux et al. Road; thence in an easterly direction following said road until intersecting the Charles Boudreaux et al. Road; thence in a northerly direction until intersecting the south side of Pumpkin Ridge; thence in a westerly direction until intersecting the F.O. Theriot Road; thence in a northerly direction to south side of Highway 1143; thence in a westerly direction to a point that intersects William Duhon Estate Road; thence in a northerly direction following said road to a point which intersects with a levee on the north property line; thence in a westerly direction following said levee until connecting School Section West Levee; thence northerly to School Section North Levee; thence westerly until connecting with High Island Ridge; thence continuing in a westerly direction until intersecting Highway 27; thence in a northerly direction following the center of Highway 27 until intersecting the Intracoastal Canal; thence in a westerly direction following the south bank of the Intracoastal Canal until intersecting the south bank of the Sweetlake Canal; thence continuing in a westerly direction following the south bank of the Sweetlake Canal until intersecting the east bank of Calcasieu Lake; thence in a southerly direction until reaching the northeast bank of Lambert Bayou; thence following the south prong of Lambert Bayou until intersecting with J. A. Davis Shell Road; thence easterly until intersecting Parish Road 388; thence south to Gravity Drainage No. 3 Canal, thence easterly until intersecting Highway 27; thence continuing in a southerly direction until intersecting Trosclair Road; thence from the south side of Trosclair Road easterly until it intersects with Willow Island Lane; thence westerly following said lane to Lebleu Camp Road; thence in a southerly direction following the road, to the shore of the Gulf of Mexico; thence in an easterly direction following the shore line of the Gulf of Mexico until intersecting the east bank of the Mermentau River Channel and the place of beginning.

- (l) *Precinct 14* Beginning at the intersection of State Highway 27/82 and Beach Road, thence in a southerly direction following Beach Road to its intersection with Broussard Beach Road; thence following Broussard Beach Road to its intersection with Willow Lane; thence in an easterly direction following Willow Lane to its intersection with Trosclair Road; thence in a northwesterly direction following Trosclair to its intersection with State Highway 27/82; thence in a westerly direction following State Highway 27/82 to point of commencement.

- (m) *Precinct 15* Beginning at the intersection of Lambert Bayou and the southeast bank of Calcasieu Lake; thence in a westerly direction following the bank of Calcasieu Lake to its intersection with the east fork of Calcasieu Lake; thence in a southerly direction following east fork of Calcasieu Lake to East Fork Road; thence following East Fork Road to its intersection with Wakefield Road; thence following Wakefield Road in a southerly direction to its intersection with Gravity Drainage District No. Three Canal; thence following the Gravity Drainage District No. Three Canal in an easterly direction to its intersection with Amoco Road; thence in a southerly direction following Amoco Road to its intersection with Smith Circle; thence in an easterly direction following Smith Circle to its intersection with Recreation Center Lane; thence in an Easterly direction following Recreation Center Lane to its intersection with Franklin Street; thence in an Easterly direction following Franklin Street to its intersection with School Street; thence in a southerly direction following School Street to its intersection with Asa Street; thence in an easterly direction following Asa Street to its intersection with Dan Street; thence in a southerly direction following Dan Street to its intersection with State Highway 27/82; thence in a westerly direction following State Highway 27/82 to its intersection with Davis Road; thence in a southerly direction following Davis Road to its intersection with the Gulf of Mexico Shoreline; thence in a easterly direction following the Gulf of Mexico shoreline to its intersection with LeBleu Camp Road; thence in a Northerly direction following LeBleu Camp Road to its intersection with Broussard Beach Road; thence in a westerly direction following Broussard Beach Road to its intersection with Beach Road; thence in a northerly direction following Beach Road to its intersection with State Highway 27/82; thence in an easterly direction following State Highway 27/82, thence in a northerly direction following State Highway 27/82 to its intersection with Gravity Drainage District No. 3 Canal, thence in a westerly direction following the Gravity Drainage District No. 3 Canal to its intersection with Earl Road; thence in a northerly direction following Earl Road to its intersection with J.A. Davis Shell Road; thence in a Northerly direction following J.A. Davis Shell Road to its intersection with Lambert Bayou; thence in a northerly direction following Lambert Bayou to its intersection with the southeast bank of Calcasieu Lake, said being the point of beginning.
- (n) *Precinct 16A*: **BOUNDARIES CHANGED BY ORDINANCE ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015** Beginning at a point where the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line meets State Highway 385, THENCE in a southerly direction following State Highway 385 to its intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a westerly direction following State Highway 384 to its intersection with the Big Lake Pontoon Bridge at the Intracoastal Waterway, THENCE following the east bank of the Intracoastal Waterway in a southerly direction to the point where the levee between the Intracoastal Waterway meets the southern boundary of Willow Lake (also being the boundary between current U.S. Census blocks 2151 and 2147), THENCE following the impoundment/bank of Willow Lake in an easterly direction, then in a northerly direction to its intersection with Lateral 15 of Gravity Drainage District No. 8, THENCE in a northerly direction following Lateral 15 of Gravity Drainage District No. 8 to its connection to the northwest point of the northern bank of the marsh impoundment (being the boundary between current U.S. Census blocks 2141 and 2142), THENCE in an easterly direction along the aforesaid marsh impoundment to its intersection with Tans Road (being the boundary between current U.S. Census blocks 2141 and 2142), THENCE in a northerly direction following Tans Road to its intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a westerly direction along State Highway 384 to its intersection with Big Diamond Disposal Road (formerly known as Odell Vincent

Road), THENCE in a northerly direction on Big Diamond Disposal Road (Odell Vincent Road) to its intersection with the South levee of the Big Diamond levee impoundment, THENCE in a westerly direction along the impoundment levee, then continuing in a northerly direction on the impoundment levee, to its intersection with the South bank of Black Bayou (also being the boundary between U.S. Census blocks 2112 and 2113), THENCE in a Northerly direction along Black Bayou to its intersection with the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line, THENCE in a westerly direction along the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish line to the point where it meets State Highway 385, this being the point of commencement.

- (o) *Precinct 16B: **BOUNDARIES CHANGED BY ORDINANCE ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015*** Beginning at a point where the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line meets the South Fork of Black Bayou, THENCE in an easterly direction along the Parish Line until it intersects with Broussard Road, THENCE in a southerly direction along Broussard Road, as it changes names to Fournerat Road to its intersection with the centerline of Sweet Lake Camp Road (which is then joined with State Highway 384), THENCE in a southerly direction along Sweet Lake Camp Road to the intersection whereby State Highway 384 turns east, THENCE in an easterly direction along State Highway 384 as it crosses the intersection with State Highway 27, and continue easterly as it changes names to Par Road 443, and then continue southerly on Par Road 443 to the intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a westerly direction along State Highway 384 to its intersection with State Highway 27, THENCE in a southerly direction along State Highway 27 to its intersection with the Intracoastal Waterway, THENCE in a westerly direction along the Intracoastal Waterway to its intersection with the eastern bank of Sweet Lake (at the eastern bank of the opening in the levee impoundment), THENCE in a northerly direction along the impound along the eastern bank of Sweet Lake to its intersection with the Sweet Lake Camp Drainage canal, THENCE in a northerly direction along the Sweet Lake Camp drainage canal to its intersection with Sweet Lake Camp Road at the Unical Timber Bridge, THENCE, in a northerly direction along Sweet Lake Camp Road to its intersection with W Precht Road, THENCE in a westerly direction along W Precht Road to its intersection with N Precht Road, THENCE in a northerly direction along N Precht Road to its intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a westerly direction along State Highway 384 to its intersection with Big Diamond Disposal Road (formerly known as Odell Vincent Road), THENCE in a northerly direction on Big Diamond Disposal Road (Odell Vincent Road) to its intersection with the South levee of the Big Diamond levee impoundment, THENCE in a westerly direction along the impoundment levee, then continuing in a northerly direction on the impoundment levee, to its intersection with the South bank of Black Bayou (also being the boundary between U.S. Census blocks 2112 and 2113), THENCE in a northerly direction along Black Bayou to its intersection with the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish Line, this being the point of commencement.
- (p) *Precinct 16C: **BOUNDARIES CHANGED BY ORDINANCE ADOPTED JUNE 4, 2015*** Beginning at the Cameron/Calcasieu Parish line at the intersection of E Ward Line Road, Broussard Road, and Cox Road, THENCE in a southerly direction on Broussard Road as it changes names to Fournerat Road to its intersection with the centerline of Sweet Lake Camp Road (which is then joined with State Highway 384), THENCE in a southerly direction along Sweet Lake Camp Road to the intersection whereby State Highway 384 turns east, THENCE in an easterly direction along State Highway 384, as it crosses the intersection with State Highway 27 and continue easterly as it changes names to Par Road 443, and then continue in a southerly direction along Par Road 443 to the intersection with State Highway 384, THENCE in a westerly direction along State Highway 384 to its intersection with State Highway 27, THENCE in a southerly direction along State Highway 27 to its intersection with the Intracoastal Waterway, THENCE in an easterly direction along the Intracoastal Waterway to its intersection with Lacassine Bayou, THENCE in a northerly direction following Lacassine Bayou to its intersection with the Cameron/Jefferson Davis Parish Line, THENCE in a westerly direction following the Cameron/Jefferson Davis Parish Line and continuing westerly at the Cameron/Calcasieu/Jefferson Davis Parish Line intersection to the intersection with Broussard Road, this being the point of commencement.

- (q) *Precinct 17—East Division (Police Jury District No. 4)*: Beginning at the intersection of the Mermentau River Channel and the Gulf of Mexico; thence in an easterly direction following the Gulf of Mexico shoreline to its intersection with the Cameron-Vermilion Parish Line; thence in a northerly direction following the Cameron-Vermilion Parish Line to its intersection with the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway; thence in a westerly direction following the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway to its intersection with the Mermentau River; thence in a southerly direction following the Mermentau River through Grand Lake and continuing to follow the Mermentau River in a westerly direction to its intersection with Mermentau River Road; thence in a northerly direction following Mermentau River Road to its intersection with Chenier Perdue Road; thence in a westerly direction following Chenier Perdue Road to its intersection with the centerline of Pumpkin Ridge Road; thence in a southerly direction following Pumpkin Ridge Road to its intersection with the Mermentau River Road; thence in a westerly direction following Mermentau River Road to the centerline of King's Bayou; thence in a southerly direction following the centerline of King's Bayou to its intersection with the centerline of the Mermentau River; thence in a southerly direction following the Mermentau River through Lower Mud Lake to the Mermentau River Channel; thence following the Mermentau River Channel in a southerly direction to the Gulf of Mexico, this being the point of beginning.
- (r) *Precinct 17—West Division (Police Jury District No. 5)*: Beginning at a point where Pumpkin Ridge Road intersects with Chenier Perdue Road; thence in a westerly direction along Chenier Perdue Road to its intersection with the Little Chenier Canal; thence in a southerly direction following the Little Chenier Canal to its intersection with Pumpkin Ridge; thence in a westerly direction following Pumpkin Ridge to its intersection with the Shell Oil-Kings Bayou Road; thence in a southerly direction following the Shell Oil-Kings Bayou Road to its intersection with State Highway 82; thence in an easterly direction following State Highway 82 to its intersection with the centerline of the Mermentau River; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection with the centerline of King's Bayou; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection with Mermentau River Road; thence in an easterly direction to its intersection with Pumpkin Ridge Road; thence in a northerly direction to its intersection with Chenier Perdue Road, this being the point of beginning.
